Eligibility

Competition is open to full-time students in grades 10, 11 and 12 enrolled in public, private or parochial high schools in Newport News, Hampton, Poquoson, York County, Williamsburg-James City County. Homeschooled youth ages 14-17 may also enter.

Entry Rules (Please read carefully)

1. All works must be **ORIGINAL**. Manipulations of copyrighted images and reproductions will not be accepted.
2. Each student may submit **one** entry.
3. Works in any medium are eligible.
4. Size restrictions, no more than: 32 x 42 inches for 2-dimensional works; 36 x 36 x 36 for 3-dimensional works.
5. Complete the entry form and attach identification label to the upper back (2-D) or bottom (3-D).
6. All work must have been completed during Summer 2018 or the 2018-19 school year; homeschool students, June 2018 to present.
7. All entries must be ready to exhibit. All 2-D works must be matted.
Students are encouraged to frame and wire their work for hanging. Or, work can be covered with clear acetate with NO hangers; they will be installed by PFAC with L-hooks. No sawtooth hangers.
8. No exhibited or sold works may be removed before the close of the exhibition.

Although reasonable care will be taken, Peninsula Fine Arts Center does not assume responsibility for lost or damaged works.

Juror:

Ed Obermeyer, Artist, Retired Art Teacher

A retired art teacher with 34 years of service (30 in middle school) in Virginia Beach Public Schools, Ed Obermeyer completed his career as an art teacher at Ocean Lakes High School. As the AP Art Teacher he taught AP 2D Design, AP2D Drawing and AP 3D Design, as well as Sculpture, Art Foundations, and Advanced Art. While teaching, Obermeyer painted surfboards, pinstriped cars and motorcycles, custom airbrush work, did freelance work, local art shows, and gallery exhibitions. Obermeyer has embarked on his journey as a full time professional artist. He received his Bachelor of Fine Arts (Art Education) and Master of Interdisciplinary Studies from Virginia Commonwealth University in Richmond.
