Eligibility

Competition is open to full-time students in grades 10, 11 and 12 enrolled in public, private or parochial high schools in Newport News, Hampton, Poquoson, York County, Williamsburg-James City County. Homeschooled youth ages 14-17 may also enter.

Entry Rules (Please read carefully)

1. All works must be **ORIGINAL**. Manipulations of copyrighted images and reproductions will not be accepted.
2. Each student may submit **one** entry.
3. Works in any medium are eligible.
4. Size restrictions, no more than: 32 x 42 inches for 2-dimensional works; 36 x 36 x 36 for 3-dimensional works.
5. Complete the entry form and attach identification label to the upper back (2-D) or bottom (3-D).
6. All work must have been completed during Summer 2019 or the 2019-2020 school year; homeschool students, June 2019 to present.
7. All entries must be ready to exhibit. All 2-D works must be matted.
Students are encouraged to frame and wire their work for hanging. Or, work can be covered with clear acetate with NO hangers; they will be installed by PFAC with L-hooks. No sawtooth hangers.
8. No exhibited or sold works may be removed before the close of the exhibition.

Responsibility

Although reasonable care will be taken, Peninsula Fine Arts Center does not assume responsibility for lost or damaged works.

Juror:

Josh Ostraff serves as an Assistant Professor of Art at Thomas Nelson Community College in the Fine Arts Area. He received his BFA in painting and Drawing at Brigham Young University and his MFA in Painting and Drawing at the University of Minnesota Twin Cities Campus. Josh is a multimedia artist who has exhibited his paintings, drawings, films, and art books both internationally and nationally with a strong interest in community-based collaboration and art projects. He is constantly looking out for ways to use art and design as a means to explore, question, create, discuss, connect, and engage.
